CCCS Summer Camp!

We are proud to present our 2018 CCCS Summer Camp! This summer will be filled with 5 exciting 2 week camp sessions hosted by our very own CCCS teachers. Each session will run from 7:30am to 5:00pm and is designed to engage and excite our students. Camp is offered to all current CCCS students who are entering 1st- 5th grade. Each 2 week session is \$300. Students can sign up for one week increments for \$150. There will be a \$25 activity charge for each session. Students may also attend on a daily basis for a drop-in rate of \$40 per day. Late fees for pick up after 5:00 pm will be at a rate of \$1 per minute. Please sign up for your chosen sessions no later than May 23rd. We need an accurate count as sessions cannot be held without a minimum of 6 students. Session 1 Sports/Science May 29 - June 8 (No camp May 28)

Teacher: Linda Kwok Do you like to figure out how things work, experiment with food and test your sports skills, then this is the camp for you! This camp offers student a chance to exercise and be a scientist! There will be a variety of fun fitness challenges as well as exciting hands-on science experiments.

Session 2 STEAM/VBS June 11-15 (STEAM Camp)

Teacher: Zach McKenzie STEAM Summer Camp is an exciting, hands-on learning opportunity for kids with a special emphasis on the STEAM curriculum areas (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) This camp will have a technology emphasis and will be held in the computer lab.

This camp will be be a mix of VBS and camp time. From 8:30am-12pm students will be escorted to our Calvary Chapel Las Vegas VBS program held in the high school building. At 12:00pm students will be picked up by the teacher and will spend the rest of the day learning to produce funny, creative writing.

Session 3 Arts and Crafts June 25-6 (No camp July 4th)

Teacher: Dell Tabaniag This camp will focus on major art projects* consisting of 2-3 paintings on canvas/panel and a paper mache sculpture during the two week period. This will be combined with learning smaller daily arts and crafts such as drawing, shading, origami, tie dye, pop-up cards, and more! The second week we will be an "America is Awesome!" theme in celebration of Independence Day! (*students that are dropped in on a day to day basis may not be able to participate in major art projects as they require several consecutive days to complete...daily arts and crafts will be substituted)

Session 4 Theater/Reading & Writing July 9 - July 20

Teacher: Diane Butera This camp will offer students the opportunity to showcase their theater gifts and talents. Students will read, write and perform scripts and plays.

Session 5 Games/Crafts July 23 - Aug 3

Teacher: Ian Gough This camp will be a mix of games and crafts. This will be an active unit with lots of play exercise and exciting crafts. Students will be learning new games both indoor and outdoor.
