CCCS Discipline Policies

Cheating = 3 demerits + Lunch Detention for an assignment, 3 demerits + Saturday detention for test or assessment. Students receive a 0 on assignment or assessment in question.

Violations may include:

- Plagiarism
- Copying
- Unpermitted use of notes, text, or electronics

Class Disruption = 1 demerit + possible Lunch Detention

If student continues after 3 issued demerits, send student to office.

Violations may include:

- Excessive talking
- Interrupting instruction
- Not on task
- Distracting other students
- Playing with nuisance items
- Passing notes
- Leaving seat excessively

Destruction or Misuse of School Property = 3 demerits and student will be held responsible for damages

Disrespect or Insubordination = 1-3 demerits + Lunch Detention depending on severity of situation.

If situation progresses beyond management, please alert administration.

Dress Code Violation = 1 demerit

Violating any of the following results in a demerit:

- All males must have their chapel shirts tucked in
- Polos must be worn at all times, even under winter apparel
- Pants must be black or khaki (no grey, no navy)
- Shoes must be close toed and have back or ankle strap
- Sweatpants, leggings, yoga pants, basketball shorts, pajama pants, and cargo shorts are not permitted
- Uniform shorts must be knee length or at most 3 inches above the knee
- Bandanas cannot be worn at any time; hats beanies, or hoods may not be worn indoors during school hours.
- All sweatshirts and outerwear must be Calvary
- PE uniforms cannot be worn outside of PE

- Undershirts must be of a solid color without graphics
- Facial piercings must not be worn during school hours
- Blankets are not permitted at any time
- No unnaturally colored hair

Free Dress or Friday Dress code

- No ripped or distressed jeans (even if skin is not shown)
- Shorts must be no more than 3 inches above the knee
- No tank tops or spaghetti straps
- No open toed shoes, flip-flops, slippers, or high heels. Sandals must have a full back or strap.
- No sheer, short, or low cut tops (stomach shown at any time)
- No altered school shirts (cut, dyed, distressed)
- No sweats, pajamas, yoga pants, leggings, or basketball shorts
- No dresses or skirts
- No underwear is to be shown

Eating in Class (includes gum and any beverage other than water) = 1 demerit

Fighting/Physical Harassment = Automatic 1-3 Day Suspension

Further consequences determined case by case

Improper Use of Electronics = 1 demerit and possible revocation of electronics privileges for the day

Violations may include:

- Not on task using Chromebook
- Looking up inappropriate content (in such cases, notify administration)
- Mistreating or being rough with school electronics
- No earbuds or headphones of any kind during school hours

Inappropriate Language or Action = 3 demerits

Violations may include:

- Cussing
- Public Displays of Affection

In Off-Limits Area = 3 demerits + Saturday Detention

Any area known to be off-limits or students anywhere without supervision.

Leaving Property Unauthorized = Automatic Suspension

Out of Class Without Hall Pass = 1 demerit

Phone Usage During School Hours = 1 demerit

If you see it, you take it and bring it to the office. The first offense, they get it back at the end of the day. The second offense, they get it back the next day. The third and every offense after, the parent has to come pick up the phone and a \$30 fine is paid.

Possession of Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco, Vaping Products, Pornography, Weapons

First Offense = Automatic 1-5 Day Suspension

Second offense = Expulsion

Skipping Class = 3 demerits and Automatic Saturday Detention

Stealing = First offense, 3 demerits and Automatic Saturday Detention. Second offense, Automatic Suspension.

Unexcused Tardy (except first period) = 1 demerit
