Code of Conduct

Academic Requirements

Academics are the number one priority, so athletes must maintain a 65% in every class, in order to participate in sports.

- If a player is late or missed a practice, at minimum the player does not start the next game.

Player/Parent Responsibilities

- A player being disrespectful to teachers/coaches will result in the player sitting on the bench.
- Inappropriate conduct on or off the field by a player could result in removal from the team at the coach's or administration's discretion.
- Parents talking to a player during the game or coming up to bench except due to injury will
 result in the player sitting on the bench.
- Parents' inappropriate language/behavior during a game will result in the player sitting on the bench.
- Volunteers are necessary to run the athletic program: (concessions, gate, set up, clean up, fundraising...). Each player must have a friend or family member volunteer at at least 2 games for each season the athlete plays.
- Players are responsible for and take care of uniforms & equipment or are charged the replacement fee.
- Players are responsible for keeping facilities, uniforms, equipment, and locker rooms clean at all times.

Participation in the CCCS athletic program is dependent upon the athlete's adherence to the above policies.
